- 2–3 hours, mid-week, at a site across Nassau, Suffolk, Queens, or Brooklyn.
- A welcome and site orientation from LIC staff
- Guided hands-on planting and/or invasive removal
- A closing reflection on what your team accomplished
- A post-event impact summary with photos — perfect for internal communications and social media
- Recognition of your company's contribution to LIC's ongoing restoration work
